## N.A.T.U.R.E. In-school Programs

### Weather

Through hands-on experiments in the classroom, students explore weather phenomena such as cloud formation and precipitation. Outside, students search for microclimates and take measurements for a real weather forecast.

Recommended for grade 5.  
Available March through June.

### Air and Water

Through hands-on experiments in the classroom and in the schoolyard, students investigate the properties of air and water and their importance to plants, animals and people.

Recommended for grade 2.  
Available March through June.

### Soils in the Environment

Be prepared to get down and dirty as students discover that soil is more than dirt. Student will explore all aspects of soil, from the minerals that are the soil's foundation to the air, water and organic materials that support the life in the soil.

Recommended for grade 3  
Available May and June.

### Nature in the Schoolyard

Explore your schoolyard with new eyes. You'll be surprised by who lives there. Investigate their characteristics and needs. Trace their life cycles and build food webs.

Recommended for grades 1, 2 and 4.  
Available May and June.
