What is the Water Quality Index?

The Canadian Council of Ministers of the Environment (CCME) uses a convenient way of summarizing complicated water quality data so that people can understand the overall results better. The Water Quality Index (WQI) considers how many tests are at or above the standards, how often they are at or above the standards, and by how much they are above the standards. The quality of the water is then scored out of 100. The higher the score, the better the quality of the water.
